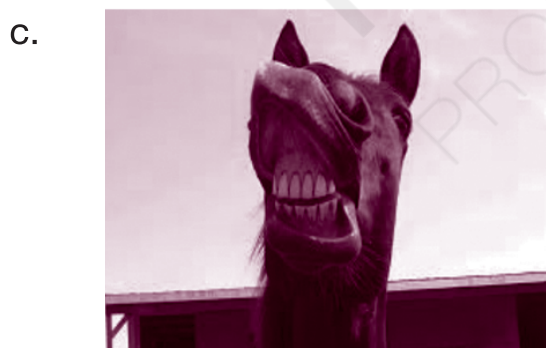

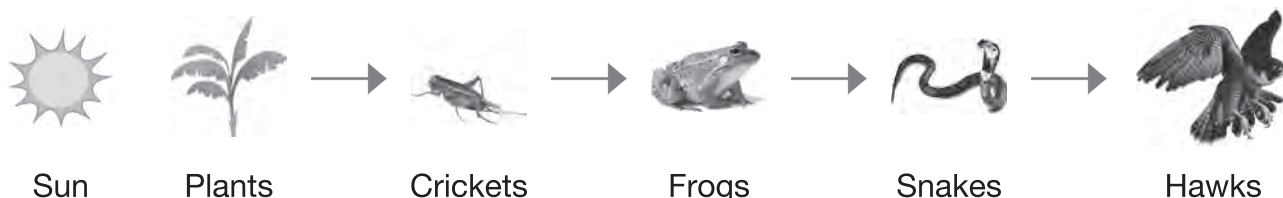
5. The following sentences describe the procedure of brushing one's teeth.
